SUMMER Term 2017

<u>Mathematics</u>	<u>Literacy and Communication</u>	<u>Understanding the World</u>
<p>This term, we will focus on solving practical problems involving counting in 'real life' and role play.</p> <p>We will also be looking at 2D and 3D shapes. Children will begin to talk about the shapes of everyday objects, e.g. 'round' and 'tall'. We will also learn about patterns, length, height and time. Children will begin to use everyday language related to money.</p> <p>During next half term the children will learn about weight, capacity and fractions.</p>	<p>In Literacy we will be focusing on children using their phonics knowledge to read books and write about different modes of transport. Children will learn to use non-fiction texts to find out a range of information about transport.</p> <p>We will continue to teach about punctuation, rhymes and alliteration.</p> <p>The stories that we will be looking at in class are: Brilliant boats; How to Catch a Star; The Darkest Dark; Lost and Found; Curious George and the Hot Air Balloon; and the magic train ride.</p> <p>You can access Jolly phonics phase 2 and 3 songs online on YouTube at home.</p>	<p>During our topic of Transport the children will explore different modes of transport. Children will be sorting transport types and observe how transport has changed overtime. Children investigating objects that float or sink.</p> <p>During our topic of 'hot and cold' we will look at different climates and what you might find in these environments, how they are the same and how they are maybe different.</p>
<u>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</u>	<u>Physical Development</u>	<u>Expressive Arts and Design</u>
<p>The children will be learning what types of behaviour are acceptable in different circumstances. They will take part in discussions about the consequences of behaviour.</p> <p>Children will be learning to empathise with 'Mr Gumpy' when reading his stories. Children will be partaking in class and group circle times.</p> <p>Reception will also be making posters about rail, water and road safety.</p>	<p>Children will also learn about the importance of: good health; physical exercise; and a healthy diet. They will talk about ways to keep healthy and safe. They will learn to manage their own basic hygiene and personal needs successfully, including dressing.</p> <p>Children exploring ways of travelling under, over and through with a focus on linking movements.</p> <p>Children will be making construction trains.</p>	<p>For our creative development we will be exploring and using a range of media to create models of transport.</p> <p>We will also be learning to use our imaginations to create transport stories that we will act out with props and music. Children will be making starry, glittery works of art for their space pictures.</p> <p>Children will be constructing junk mode aeroplane.</p>
