Class photos on Monday

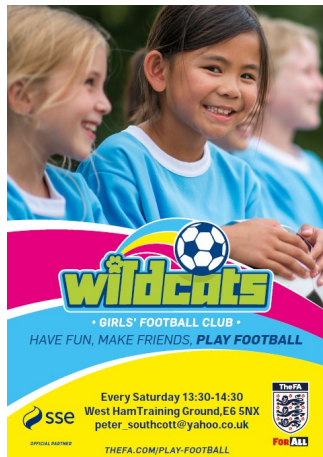
Please remember we will be having Class Photos on Monday.

30 hour Free Child Care Provision Starting in 2017

The Boleyn Trust will be offering 30 hour Free childcare for under fives from September 2017. This will be available at Cleves Primary School.

At the moment we are just enquiring within the community as to which families would be taking up this opportunity for full day nursery provision from 8.50- 3.30 for 3-5 year olds. If you are interested please contact Megan Turpin in the Cleves office so we can look at how many places we might need to provide.

We will be having a meeting about this after May half term.

Below is some of the Criteria parents have to meet to be eligible

Parents of three and four year olds will need to meet the following criteria in order to be eligible for 30 hours free childcare:

They earn or expect to earn the equivalent to 16 hours at National Minimum or Living Wage over the coming three months.

✓ This equates to £120 a week (or c.£6,000 a year) for each parent over 25 years old or £112.80 a week (or c.£5,800 a year) for each parent between 21 and 24 years old.

✓ The parent (and their partner where applicable) should be seeking the free childcare to enable them to work.

✓ Where one parent meets the income criteria and the other is unable to work because they are disabled, have caring responsibilities or have been assessed as having limited capability to work.

✓ If a non-EEA national, the parent must have recourse to public funds.
