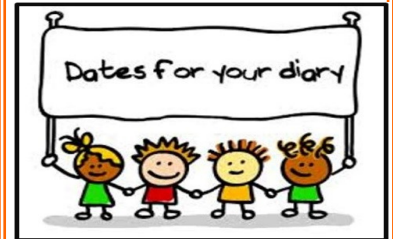

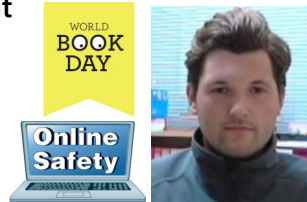
## School Council News !
