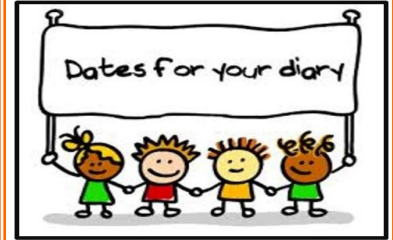
Happy Half Term

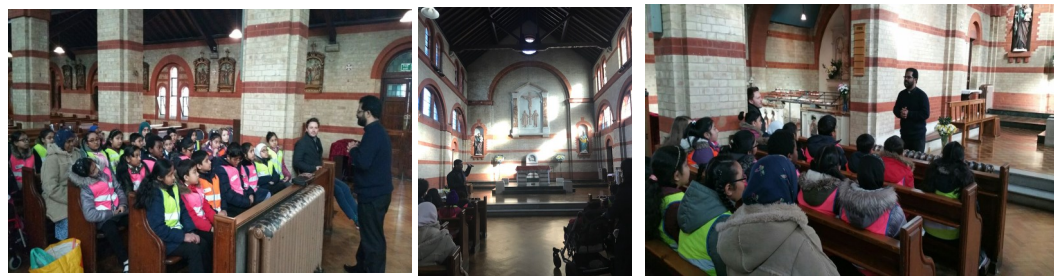
New Clubs will be starting on Monday 26th February—you will receive a letter after half term to confirm which clubs your child is in. Please see the school office for further information.
